- a) Establish a framework for data collection on rare diseases in Australia and assess how this could function internationally
- b) Compare the subsidization and equity principles of the Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme (PBS) and the LSDP (Life Saving Drugs Program)

Item a) will contribute to work being undertaken by the external contractor.

Item b) RVA's report will be provided to the Reference Group for their consideration, particularly in relation to equity principles.

The Dept will fund RVA to undertake the work – to ensure perspectives of a broad range of people with a rare diseases are included in the report.
