Understanding the NDIS webinars are national information sessions that outline the roles, responsibilities and core processes of the NDIS. These sessions support participants and communities to understand, access and navigate the scheme.

This webinar series explores a range of NDIS topics to help people build their knowledge and confidence. Sessions introduce key NDIS processes, including how to apply, how plans are created, used and changed, and the types of supports funded by the NDIS and other services. The series also explains 'Our Guidelines' and the tools we use to make decisions.

These information sessions are facilitated and delivered by the NDIS Community Engagement team.
